Basic Firearms Safety Rules:

- Treat every gun as if it were loaded.
- Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- Be sure of your target and what is beyond before you pull the trigger

Range Operating Rules:

- 1) Members and guests must sign in and pay range fees upon entering the range, prior to any use of the range.
- 2) NO alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the range area.
- 3) No tracer, incendiary, gas or explosive ammunition allowed.
- 4) Fully automatic firearms will be permitted only for special events and activities.
- 5) All air and CO2 guns are permitted (pellets only, no BB's).
- 6) Paper targets ONLY.
- 7) Steel plates may only be used for special events and designated practices. You will not be allowed to shoot jacketed rounds at steel plates.
- 8) All firearms must be unloaded and cased upon entering the range. Exception: A properly holstered, concealed handgun, which cannot be handled until on the firing line.
- 9) No firearms will be handled behind the firing line (or in the squad room of the indoor pistol range).
- 10) Only shooters and coaches will be allowed on the firing line.
- 11) All rifles not cased will be racked with actions open when not in use.
- 12) Firearms may only be handled on the firing line with the muzzle downrange. **NO shooting in FRONT OF THE FIRING LINE** except for organized events.
- 13) All shooters have the responsibility to call a cease-fire in the event of an unsafe condition.
- 14) On the command cease-fire, all shooters will stop firing, make their firearms safe (magazines out, actions open), and place them on the bench and step back from the line.
- 15) No shooter will be allowed forward of the firing line until all shooters are satisfied that all firearms on the line are unloaded, actions open and the line is safe.
- 16) **NO** handling of firearms is permitted while shooters are downrange.
- 17) If three or more members are shooting, a range officer will be designated and the range officer will have absolute authority for the safe operation of the range.
- 18) If a misfire occurs, keep the firearm pointed downrange for at least 20 seconds. If round still does not fire after several attempts, wait another 20 seconds, then remove the round. Dispose round in the appropriately marked container.
- 19) Shooters will take extra care to ensure that each shot hits the backstop. Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target. If your shot causes any damage or knowingly leaves the range, notify a board member ASAP.
- 20) **DO NOT** shoot any rounds at the ground on the out door ranges. Your point of aim must **ALWAYS** be at a backstop.

Guest Policy:

- 1) The first time a family member or guest comes to the range to shoot, they must read, understand, and sign a copy of our range safety and operating rules. You will also sign the form as a witness that your guest, in fact, did read and understand the rules. A copy will be kept at the range. This is required only on the first visit each year.
- 2) Members will share a firing point with their guest.
